On Feb. 6, the Renewable Fuels Association (RFA) released the [report](#) "Contribution of the Ethanol Industry to the Economy of the United States in 2012," an economic impact analysis performed by Cardno-ENTRIX. The analysis found that the ethanol industry supported 383,261 direct, indirect and induced jobs across all sectors of the economy in 2012.
