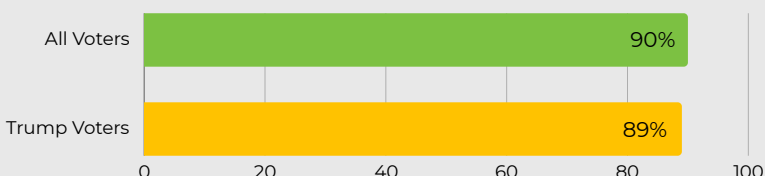


ETHANOL AND AMERICAN ENERGY INDEPENDENCE
