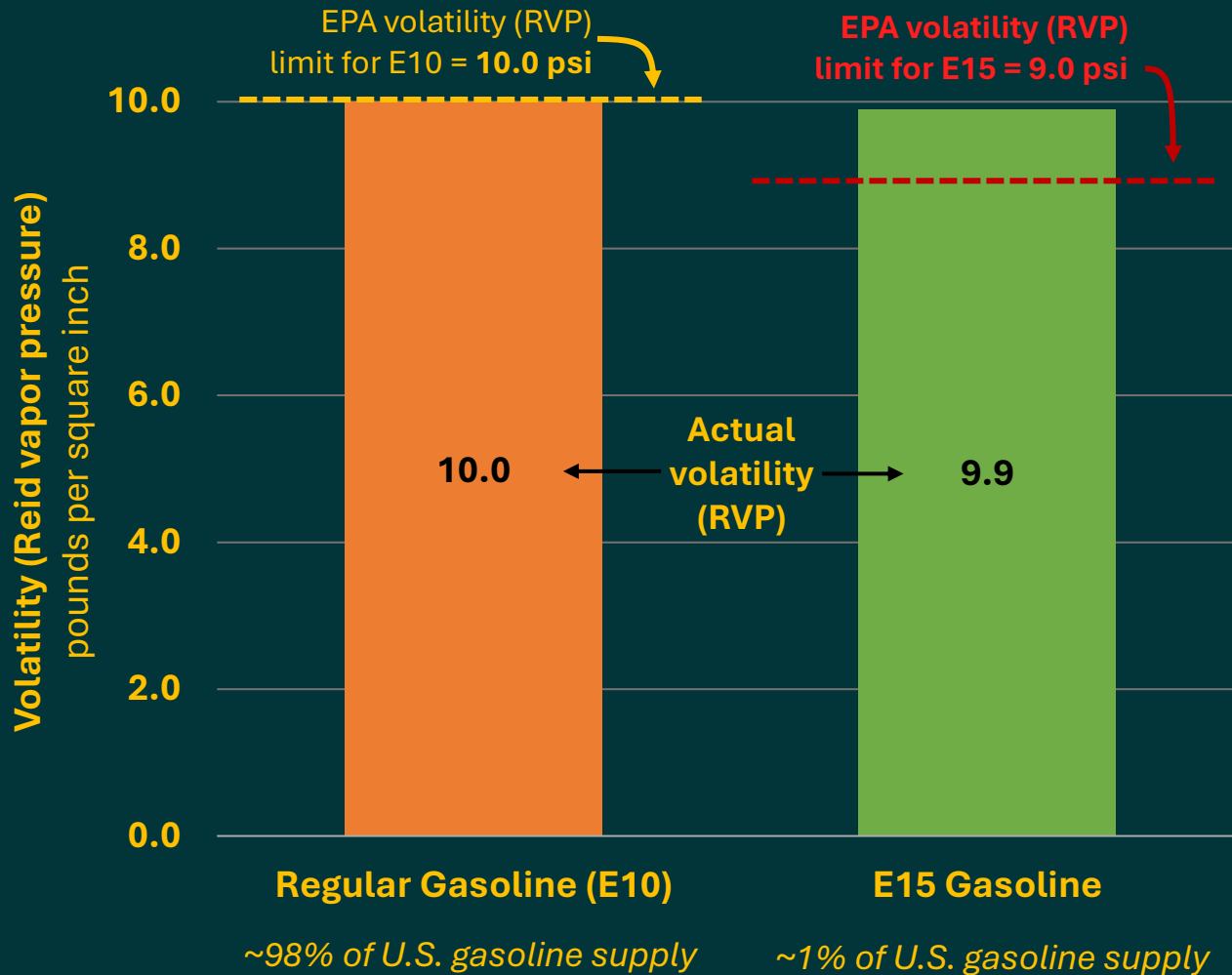


Why can't E15 be sold in the summertime?

EPA regulations hold E15 to more restrictive volatile emissions limits than regular gasoline (E10)... even though **E15 has lower emissions!**



- E15 has slightly **lower vapor pressure (RVP)** and **lower ozone/smog-forming potential** than regular gas (E10)...
- ...but E15 is held to a more restrictive summertime volatility limit than E10, due to 35-year-old EPA regulations.
- **Year-round E15 legislation would simply hold E15 to the same volatility standard as regular gasoline (E10).**
