

VOTERS WANT LOWER-COST E15

American voters — Republicans and Democrats alike — want **permanent access to lower-cost, American-made E15**. And they want it by a wide margin, according to June polling by Morning Consult. Voters support expanding the availability of lower-cost E15 to make it permanently available year-round and nationwide.

More than 7 in 10 respondents support the U.S. **increasing availability of renewable E15 to help lower fuel prices** and support energy independence. This includes 77% of Democrats and 75% of Republicans.

or nearly three-quarters of survey respondents **support legislation for year-round E15**. This includes 73% each of Democrats and Republicans.

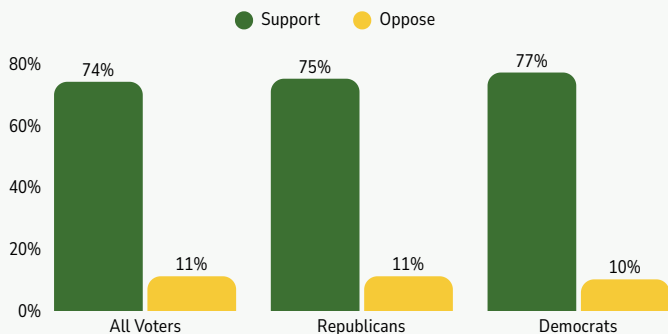

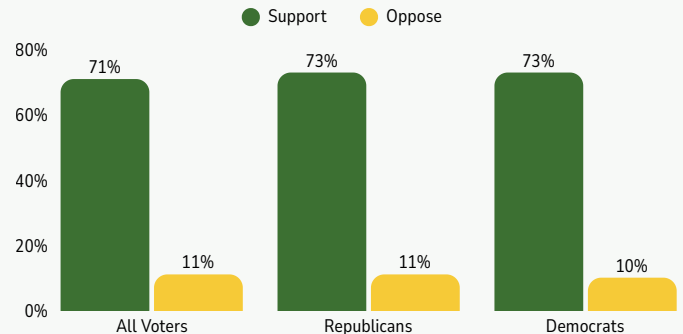

Methodology: The Morning Consult poll was conducted online June 23-25, 2026, among a sample of 2,039 registered voters. Data were weighted to approximate a target sample based on age, race/ethnicity, gender, educational attainment, 2024 presidential vote, and region. Results have a 2% margin of error.
