




- White corn area harvested in Guatemala has not declined in recent years as a result of biofuels.
- 2012/13 area harvested represented the second-highest on record, trailing only 2008/09.

- Guatemalan corn production has grown substantially since 2000.
- 2012/13 corn production is estimated at a record 1.8 million MT.
- Guatemalan corn imports have been relatively flat since 2005/06.
- Domestic production accounts for a larger share of Guatemalan corn consumption today than from 1999-2006.

- Total corn consumption has grown significantly in Guatemala since 2005.

- While total corn consumption has increased since 2005, per capita corn consumption has been trending downward.
- However, that doesn't mean Guatemalans are eating less food—per capita supplies of meat and eggs have roughly doubled since 1990, while per capita milk supplies are up by one-third.
