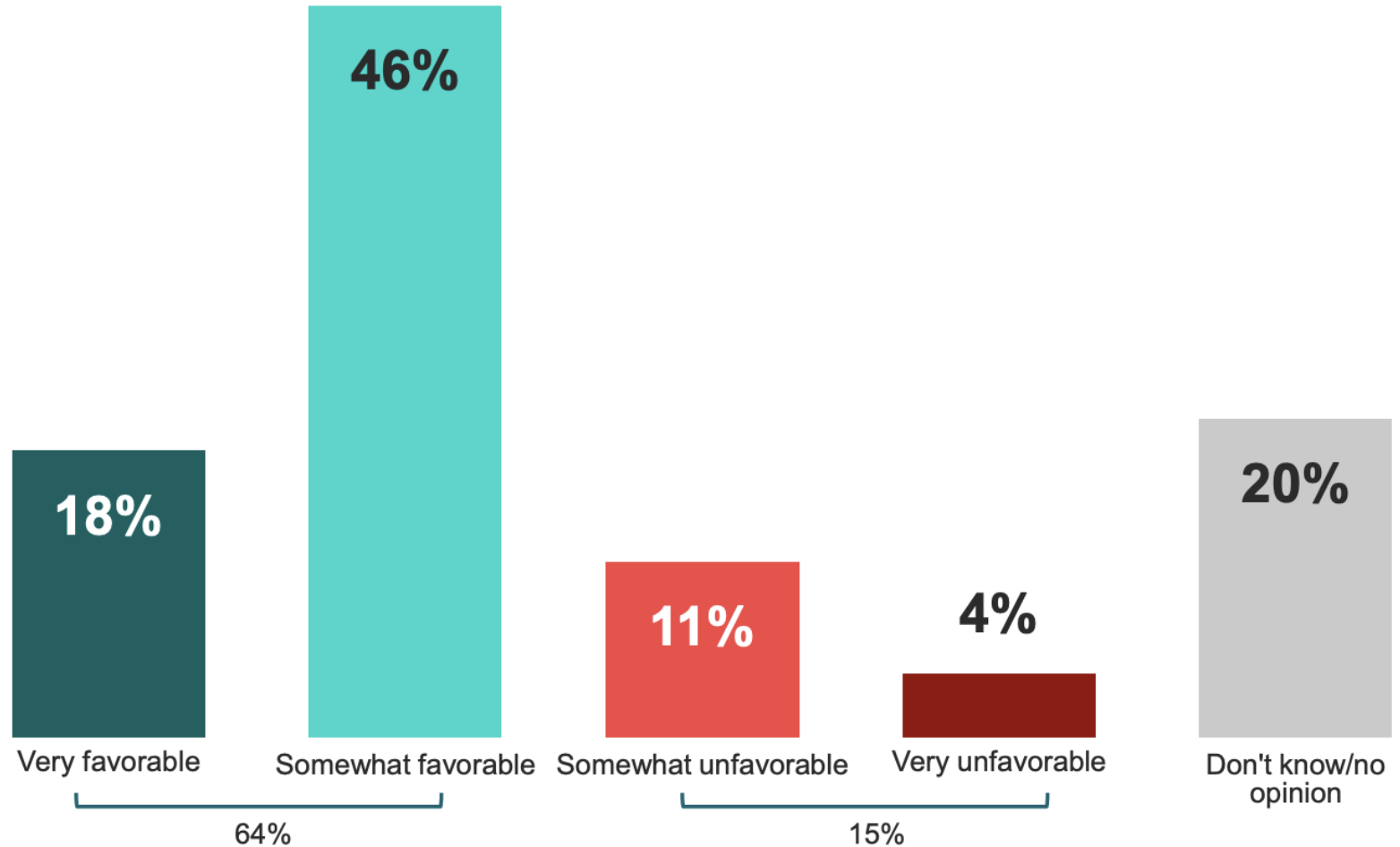


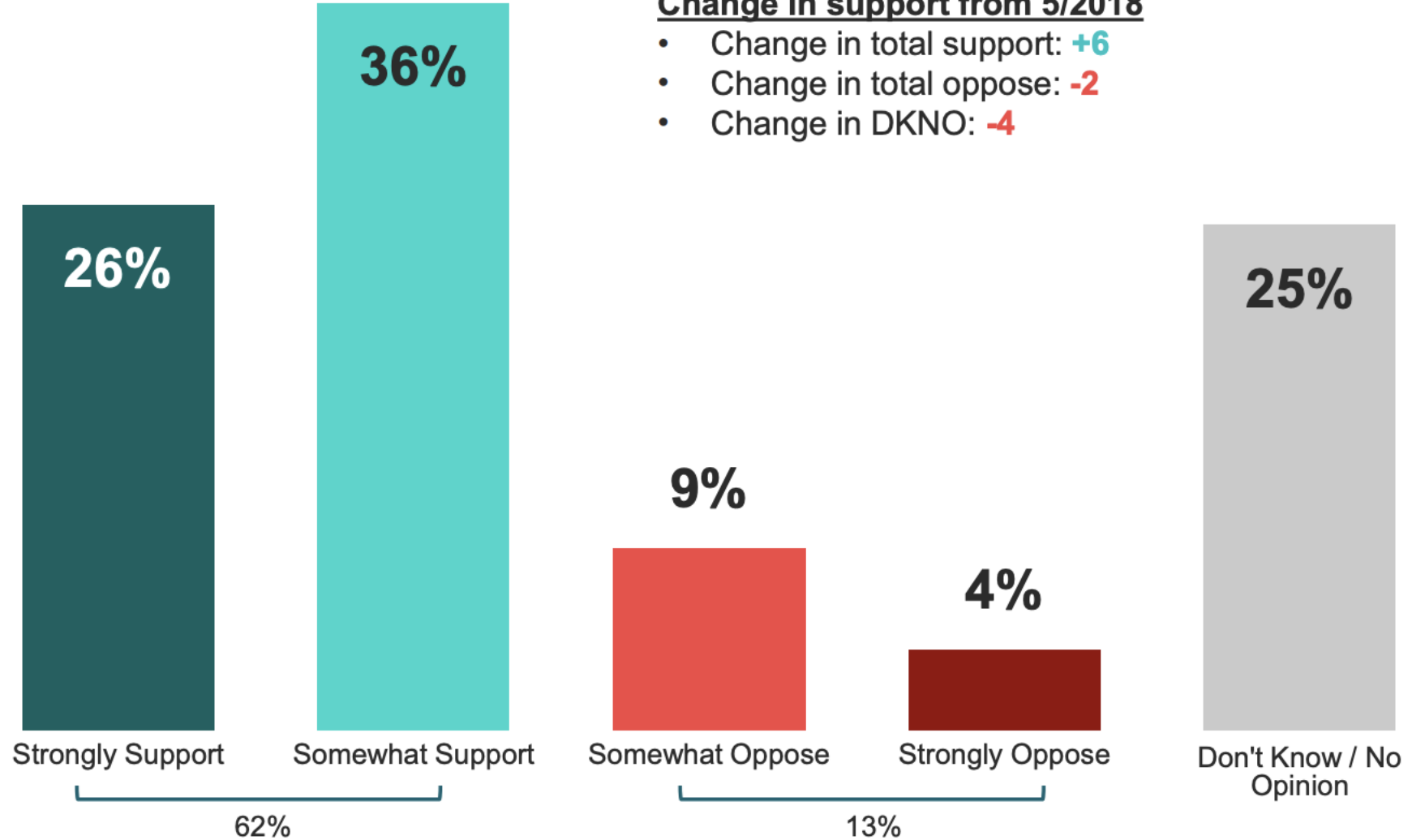

64% of voters have a favorable opinion about ethanol (64%)



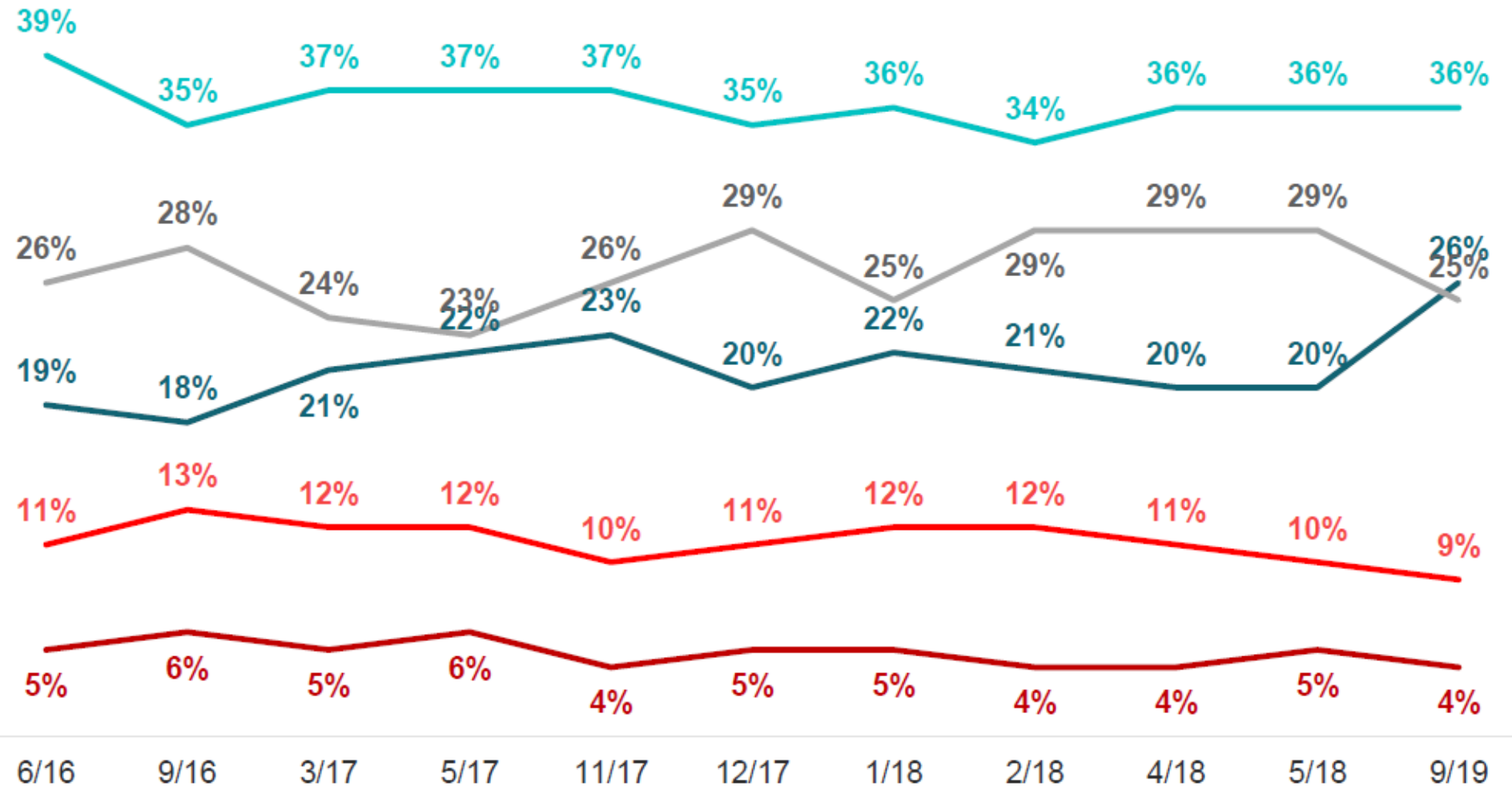
As you may know, there is currently a Renewable Fuel Standard (RFS) that requires a certain amount of the fuel produced each year to come from ethanol, biodiesel and other renewable sources that aren't fossil fuels. Do you support or oppose this requirement?

62% of voters have a favorable opinion of the Renewable Fuel Standard, an increase of 6% since May 2018.

One of the requirements of the RFS is that fuel produced at oil refineries must contain a minimum volume of renewable fuels like ethanol. Recently, President Trump allowed 31 oil refineries to obtain exemptions that excuse them from this requirement. Do you support or oppose President Trump's recent actions to exempt oil companies from the requirements of the Renewable Fuel Standard?

Half of voters oppose oil companies exemptions from the RFS, and 37% strongly oppose it
